How to join IAR at MIPIM, one of the world's largest real estate conferences

- 1. Sign up for MIPIM. IAR's booth will be in the NAR Pavilion at the conference. As part of your member benefits, you get a hefty discount (nearly \$660) by signing up through NAR. The form is located here. You'll have to print it out and fax or mail the form for security reasons. The deadline to get the reduced rate of €1,055 is March 7, 2016.
- 2. Tell IAR you'll be joining us! Fill out this <u>form</u> to make sure we know you'll be there. A booth slot is available for \$200, and based on demand additional slots may also be available. The IAR form has the details, and it will give us a way to add you to our email list so we can alert you to special REALTOR®-related events and provide conference updates.

- 3. Make your reservations: Because this is an annual show with huge international interest, accommodations can be hard to come by as the event nears. MIPIM has negotiated some reduced room rates. See them here. IAR recommends you make reservations as soon as possible. Some hotels may be a good distance away, but MIPIM does provide free shuttles in some cases. The closest airport to the conference is Nice, France, about 30 minutes outside of Cannes.
- Check your passport: If you don't
 have a passport, get one. If it's going to
 expire six months or less from the date of
 travel, you'll want to renew it rather than
 risk customs hassles or being turned away.
