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## Frequently Asked Questions

### Q. What is the cost?

A. CE classes are \$10 per credit hour for members and \$15 per credit hour for non-members.

### Q. Can I get a refund if I'm unable to attend

A. Cancellations must be made 3 days in advance of the scheduled class for a full refund or transfer to another CE class offered at Rockford Area REALTORS®.

### Q. What are the CE requirements for the April 30, 2022 Broker Renewal?

A. The requirements are as follows:

**Licensed before November 1, 2019:** 12 hours of CE must include 4 hours of Core CE, 8 hours of elective CE that must include at least 1 hour of sexual harassment prevention training.

**Licensed between November 1, 2019- October 31, 2021:** 45-hour Broker Post License must include three 15-hour courses, each ending with a 50-question exam. The post-license curriculum includes the required Sexual Harassment Prevention training.

**Licensed on or after November 1, 2021:** No renewal for 2021. 45-hour Broker Post License must be completed **on or before April 30, 2024** and must include three 15-hour courses, each ending with a 50-question exam. The post-license curriculum includes the required Sexual Harassment Prevention training.

### Q. What are the fees for Managing Broker license renewal?

A. The Managing Broker renewal fee is \$150. A \$50 late payment penalty fee is charged for any renewals after the After the April 30, 2022 deadline.
